Chinese Restaurant Outing to Euroa





On Wednesday 17th July a group of residents went on a lovely outing to Euroa for a very special luncheon at the Chinese Restaurant.


This is a very popular restaurant in Euroa and came highly recommended.



The menu had so many choices with something for everyone.










A Darlingford Recipe Book.....
